
How it Works

Purchase a Lot

Upon mutual acceptance of a Purchase Agreement between Buyer & Seller, and once Buyers purchase funds have been received by the Title Co. for the pre-finished Lot(s) purchase, and under the terms of this offering.

(Once all of the subdivisions construction of it's horizontal infrastructure has been completed and accepted by the City of Grand Junction, then the Title Co. will process the paperwork and a Grant Deed will be issued transfereing the Lot(s) and new Title to your name upon the escrow's closing date)
